What to expect at group lessons?

- Please arrive no more than 15 minutes in advance of your scheduled class time.
- Entrance and exit are two separate doors.
- One adult per skater.
- Stop at Check-In Table for Health Screening & Sign-In.
- We will let you know your lesson group and coach.
- You can stay on the ice for 30-minutes of open skate after lesson. Sign up for extra.
- Chairs will be in lobby to put skates on (no skate rentals this year).
- When directed you will bring all of your things into the rink.
- Parent can leave through exit door and come back to pick up or sit on bleachers in rink.
- When done on the ice please take off skates and exit within 10 minutes.
- ONLY Town Staff, CFSC Volunteers, and Coaches will be permitted to stay in lobby.
- Parents who pick up please meet your child at the exit door outside.

What do I need to wear?

- Skates with proper ankle support that have been sharpened.
- We strongly recommend a bicycle helmet for younger/beginner skaters.
- Gloves and hats are recommended to help keep children warm.
- We recommend leggings, sweatshirts, sweatpants or figure skating wear. Denim jeans are discouraged as they restrict range of motion.
- Double runner blades are not permitted.
- Hard guards are required when walking with skates off the ice.

Who can take private lessons?

- Skaters at any level can take private lessons.
- Lesson time and cost are determined between coach and skater.
- Skaters, at any level, in private lessons can enter competitions.
- The club can provide contact information for private coaches.

What is open skate?

- CFSC skaters have open ice times to practice and take private lessons.
- **New:** Skaters will have 30-minutes of open skate right after their group lessons.
- Open skate on Thursdays other than after lessons must be reserved in advance.
- Open skate is available on Sundays and Saturdays on a first-come-first-served basis.
- Reservation information will be emailed.
