



Mandatory Figure Skating Rules of Etiquette and Safety for Skaters, Parents, & Coaches

The Camillus Figure Skating Club is committed to providing our skaters with a safe and positive environment where they can develop physically, emotionally and socially. The following rules of etiquette will help to ensure our skater's safety as well as promote an environment of sportsmanship.

Basic Rules

- No IPODS, cell phones, radios, headphones, food or gum is allowed on the ice.
- No stopping to socialize on the ice as this can be hazardous to other skaters.
- Must follow all health and safety rules put forth by CFSC, Town of Camillus, and any facility we are using.

Skating Right of Way Protocols

Always yield to a skater in higher priority than yourself. This means watch for these skaters, let them always have the right of way and be sure to get out of their way. The priorities are listed below:

- 1st Priority: Skaters in a lesson who are having their music played
- 2nd Priority: Skaters in a lesson
- 3rd Priority: Skaters having their program/dance music played

Where to do Jumps and Spins

Jumps: Jumps are to be performed in the corners of the rink.

Spins: Spins are generally practiced in the center circle of the rink.

The exception to these rules is program practices, where jumps and spins are skated as choreographed.

Code of Conduct

Each skater, parent, guardian, and coach are required to encourage good sportsmanship by their actions; demonstrating positive support for all skaters, coaches and officials and maintaining a respectful and courteous attitude to others regardless of race, sex, creed, or ability. There will be a zero tolerance for bullying of any type, including social media. Skaters and coaches may not allow others to use their skating credentials for any reason.

Any violation of the rules of etiquette and safety above will result in, but is not limited to one of the following actions:

- Verbal warning • 1 (One) week suspension from the club • Removal from club with no refund of fees

Please report any problems or complaints to a board member so an incident report can be filled out. Each incident will be reviewed by the board and disciplinary actions will be determined accordingly.

CFSC reserves the right to take immediate action at any time which includes removal from ice/facility.
